SECY-82-255 - ABNORMAL OSCURRENCE RECOMMENDATION - PRESSURE TRANSIENTS DURING SHUTDOWN AT A NUCLEAR POWER PLANT

This is to advise you that the Commission (with all Commissioners agreeing) has approved the proposed abnormal occurrence and the associated Federal Register Notice subject to:

 Modifying lines 6 and 7 of page 3 to read "...which close at 465 psig to prevent over pressurizing the RHR system. The RHR system..."; and

2. the inclusion of a diagram.

You should also reexamine the statement on the first line of page 6 which states that a pressure increase of "undetermined origin" occurred. If it is not significant that it is of undetermined origin the Commission suggests that you drop the phrase; if it is significant, the Commission would like to know if the licensee is examining it. You should make the above changes to the Federal Register Notice and return it for publication.
