Background: SECY-82-142 dated April 2, 1982 forwarded the Fourth Quarter CY 1981 AO Report to the Commission for approval. The Turkey Point Unit 4 overpressurization events were included as an Enclosure 3 item (an item seriously considered for AO reporting, but judged not reportable after review by the staff) to the Commission paper. The Commission, in their approval of SECY-82-142, stated that the events should be considered for reporting in a subsequent AO quarterly report.

Introduction: The purpose of this briefing is to discuss the subject overpressurization events in regard to: (1) circumstances leading to the events, (2) operator response, (3) the licensee's analysis of the safety significance of the events, (4) pressure vessel safety margins, and (5) determination of significance for reporting as an abnormal occurrence.
