Subject: BOMB THREAT

At approximately 11:30 a.m. (CDT) on September 15, 1982, Iowa-Illinois Electric Company (a co-owner of the Quad Cities Nuclear Plant) received a telephone threat that a bomb would go off at noon at one of its power plants. The Quad Cities Station was advised of the threat. The licensee declared an Unusual Event and implemented its security plan bomb threat procedure. Plant areas with frequent employee and contractor access were evacuated. No explosive devices were found during a search of the plant. This event was terminated at 12:25 p.m. (CDT).

The licensee notified the FBI and local authorities.

Neither Region III (Chicago) nor the licensee plan to make a press release.

The States of Illinois and Iowa will be notified.

Region III received notification of this event by telephone from the site Resident Inspector at 11:35 a.m. (CDT). This information is current as of 1:30 p.m. (CDT), September 15, 1982.
