SUBJECT: MEETING SUMMARY - DISCUSSION OF RG 1.88

A brief meeting was held on August 31, 1982, in Bethesda, Maryland, to discuss requirements of Regulatory Guide 1.88 (RG 1.88), "Collection, Storage and Maintenance of Nuclear Power Plant Quality Assurance Records." Georgia Power Company was represented by J. Bailey of Southern Company Services, Inc., and the staff by J. Spraul and J. Grant, NRR.

The applicant requested that the staff clarify a section of ANSI N45.2.9-1974, which according to RG 1.88 is an adequate basis for complying with the pertinent quality assurance requirements of Appendix B to 10 CFR Part 50. The applicant's concern was that the criteria to be used for designing the storage facility "... from possible destruction by causes such as fire, flooding, tornadoes ...", as stated in Section 5.6 of the ANSI document, were not well-defined in respect to tornadoes.

The staff explained that if the storage facility were designed to a 4-hour minimum fire protection rating and kept in a building designed and constructed to the uniform building code, then the storage facility design would be satisfied with respect to tornado protection. Therefore, the applicant's use of a vault with a 4-hour fire protection rating that will be inside the Service Building on site is sufficient to meet the RG 1.88 design requirements for tornado protection.
