PROPOSED LICENSE TO EXPORT DEPLETED URANIUM TO CANADA

(XU08551)

On September 15, 1982 Westinghouse Electric Corporation applied for a license to export 15 kilograms of depleted uranium to Canada for equipment verification. The applicant has requested expeditious processing of the license application as the material is scheduled for shipment on September 24, 1982.

The staff has concluded that the proposed export meets the requirements of the Atomic Energy Act, as amended, and, and would not be inimical to the common defense and security of the United States.

In view of the above considerations, the staff issued the license without the normal 15-day waiting period.
