Dear Mr. Riley:

Your letter of September 12, 1982, requested that the NRC continue to send you copies of our correspondence to the Duke Power Company regarding the McGuire Nuclear Station. Your request is based on (1) your participation as an intervenor in the Catawba proceedings and (2) convenience to not have to make time consuming visits to the local public document room to obtain McGuire information.

As an intervenor and participant in the Catawba proceedings you are receiving copies of correspondence to the applicant originated by the Division of Licensing during our review of the Catawba application. In addition, this information is also available in the local public document room as is the McGuire correspondence. Be assured that any issue arising at McGuire that is germane to the licensing of Catawba will be addressed on the Catawba docket. As stated in our August 30, 1982, letter, since the McGuire proceedings to which you were an intervening party have been completed and in light of the availability of documents in the local public document room, we are discontinuing sending you copies of our McGuire correspondence to the Duke Power Company.
