D.J. Sreniawski:

This letter is to respond to your office's inspection on August 9, 1982.

The following are the steps we have taken to correct the violations.

- We have purchased a steel cabinet to store the exit signs. We will continue to use the same heavy duty padlock. We have had a sign made and installed stating "Caution Contains Radioactivity". This is over the door to the room where we store the signs. Another sign of equal size stating "This room must be evacuated immediately if any exit sign is accidently broken" has also been installed.
- 2. We made arrangements with the Saunders Roe Co., 2475 S. Stratford Rd., Winston-Salem, N.C. 27103 to file information on all of the transfers we make from our inventory. Your office should have been brought up to date by the receipt of this letter. Saunders Roe will continue to provide the transfer information in the future.

We believe we are now in compliance and our storage, signs and information system will keep us in compliance.
