Subject: NRC Inspection

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Wm. Mark Grayson of this office on July 23, 1982 of activities authorized by NCC License No. 50-19401-01, and to the discussion of our findings held by Mr. Grayson with you and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection. The results of this inspection were also discussed with you during an enforcement conference on August 23, 1982 by Mr. Thomas and Mr. Johnson of this office.

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel and observations by the inspector.

Based on the results of this inspection it appears that certain of your activities were not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements, as set forth in the Notice of Violation, enclosed herewith as Appendix A. These items have been categorized into severity levels as described in the NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C), 47 FR 9987 (March 9, 1982). Item A involving control of licensed material and Item B involving unauthorized users in the attached Notice of Violation, were classified as Severity Level IV violations after careful consideration of the factors involved in this specific instance.

In addition to the need for corrective action regarding the specific items of noncompliance included in Appendix A, we are concerned about the implementation of your management control system that permitted the items of noncompliance to occur. Your lack of effective controls is also demonstrated by four violations that are repetitive or similar to violations observed during the last inspection of your operations. These are items A, C, D and E on the attached Appendix A.
