## MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

The April 15, 1982 motion by Intervenor, Forelaws on Board, to terminate the Pebble Springs proceeding pends before the Board. Counsel for the Applicants states in the April 26 response that the motion on its face demonstrates "... -- an intent to continue the licensing proceeding and relocate the plant in another site." Our reading of the motion to terminate reveals no such intent, and in any event the parties and the Board should be more thoroughly informed by the Applicants themselves. Accordingly, the Applicants are directed to report to the Board within thirty days of the service of this order the details of the status of the application for construction permits in Docket Nos. 50-514 and 50-515. After we have evaluated Applicant's report, we will determine whether the motion to terminate should be considered on the pleadings or whether a further factual inquiry is required.
