COMMISSION REVIEW OF DIRECTOR'S
DECISION (DD-82-12) REGARDING
EMERGENCY PLANNING DEFICIENCIES

Indian Point, Units 2 and 3
January 27, 1983, as extended.

DD-82-12, denying a 2.206 petition for shutdown of Indian Point Units 2 and 3 due to emergency preparedness deficiencies, was issued by the Director of the Office of Inspection and Enforcement on November 26, 1982. We analyzed the Director's Decision in SECY-82-490, dated December 14, 1982. The Commission's decision addressing enforcement issues arising from a "120-day clock" begun pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(s) was issued on December 23, 1982, CLI-82-38. This decision did not address the earlier 2.206 petition or the Director's Decision. We believe that
