PROGRAMMATIC AGREEMENT AMONG THE NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMPILISION, THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION, THE MISSOURI STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER, AND THE UNION ELECTRIC COMPANY REGARDING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CULTURAL RESOURCE MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE CALLAWAY NUCLEAR PLANT LOCATED IN CALLAWAY COUNTY, MISSOURI

WHEREAS, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), in consultation with the Union Electric Company, proposes to designate the Union Electric Company as administrator of the Cultural Resource Management Plan for Residual Lands (Program) surrounding the Callaway Nuclear Power Plant located in Callaway County, Missouri, in accordance with the provisions of 36 CFR Parts 800.2 and 800.13, and

WHEREAS, NRC has determined that the Program may have an effect upon the properties included in or eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places and has consulted with the Advisory Council on Historic Places (Council) and the Missouri State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) pursuant to Section 800.13 of the regulations (36 CFR Part 800) implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. Section 470h-2(f), and

WHEREAS, Union Electric Company (the licensee) participated in the consultation and has been invited to concur in this Programmatic Agreement, and

WHEREAS, the definitions and terminology given in <u>APPENDIX A</u> are applicable throughout this Programmatic Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, NRC, the Council, the M.ssouri SHPO and the licensee agree that the Program shall be administered by the licensee in accordance with the following stipulations to satisfy the NRC's Section 106 responsibilities for all individual undertakings of the Program.

Stipulations

The NRC designates that the licensee, in consultation with the Missouri SHPO, will ensure that the following measures are carried out.

The Missouri SHPO may monitor activities carried out pursuant to this Programmatic Agreement, and the Council will review such activities if requested by the Missouri SHPO. The NRC will be consulted by the Council and the Missouri SHPO in the delegation of the monitoring and review responsibilities of the licensee.

V. FAILURE TO CARRY OUT TERMS OF PROGRAMMATIC AGREEMENT

In the event any party does not carry out the terms of this Programmatic Agreement, the licensee, in consultation with the NRC, the Council, and the Missouri SHPO, shall comply with 36 CFR Parts 800.4 through 800.6 with regard to individual undertakings covered by this Programmatic Agreement.
