


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Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the document referenced in Item 9A or 10A, as heretofore changed, remains unchanged and in full force and effect.

The purpose of this modification is to increase the contract ceiling by \$11,040.34, from \$93,541.20 to \$104,581.54, to delete the requirement for the Government to furnish the chain of custody forms, to revise the hourly rates shown on pages 5 and 6 of the contract to reflect loaded hourly rates which include the hours expended by all labor categories in this effort, to adjust the unit price for materials and supplies to include the additional costs involved in complying with the special requirements of the NRC's testing laboratory, to revise the travel ceilings to reflect costs only (eliminating fee) and to add new line item #6 to allow for collections made at the contractor's sites outside of Washington, DC.. The revised hourly rates and travel ceilings are effective September 13, 1989. The revised price for materials and supplies is effective January 11, 1990. The addition of line item #6 is effective April 6, 1990. Accordingly, the contract is modified as follows:

1. Block 15G of the SF26, "Total Amount of Contract", is revised to delete "\$93,541.20" and insert "\$104,581.54".

2. Section B.2, "Consideration and Obligation - Delivery Orders", is revised by deleting the amount of "93,541.20" in line 3 and inserting the amount of "104,581.54".

3. Pages 5 and 6 of the contract are deleted in their entirety and replaced with the attached Enclosures 1 and 2 to this modification.

4. Section C, Statement of Work, paragraph C.1.2.3. Add the following sentence to the first paragraph:

"Also, occasionally, applicant testing may be performed at the Contractor's facilities outside of Washington, DC at the per collection rate specified in Section B, line item 6."

5. Section H.6, "Government Furnished Material", is revised to delete the first sentence and substitute the following:

"The Government will provide the Permanent Record Book sheets."

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
