3 CHAIRMAN CARR: Good morning, ladies and
4 gentlemen.

5 This is an affirmation session. We have
6 two items to come before us this morning.

7 Before I ask the Secretary to lead us
8 through the items for affirmation, do any of my fellow
9 Commissioners have any opening comments they would
10 like to make?

11 If not, Mr. Secretary, please proceed.

12 SECRETARY CHILK: The first item, Mr.
13 Chairman, is SECY-90-209. It is the final 1990 Waste
14 Confidence Decision and Amendments to 10 CFR Part 51.

15 In this paper, the Commission is being
16 asked to approve issuance of a final waste confidence
17 decision review and final conforming amendments to 10
18 CFR Part 51. As a result of its review, the
19 Commission has revised the second and fourth findings
20 of the 1984 Waste Confidence Decision and has
21 reaffirmed the other three findings.

22 The Commission is also changing its
23 original commitment to review its decision at least
24 every five years to a commitment to review the
25 decision at least every ten years or when significant

1 and pertinent unexpected events occur.

2 All Commissioners have approved the final
3 decision review and the conforming amendments to 10
4 CFR Part 51 with modifications that are attached to
5 our memorandum of August the 15th.

6 Would you please affirm your votes?

7 CHAIRMAN CARR: Aye.

8 COMMISSIONER ROGERS: Aye.

9 COMMISSIONER CURTISS: Aye.

10 COMMISSIONER REMICK: Aye.

11 SECRETARY CHILK: The second item is SECY-
12 90-255. It's a Final Rule on Informal Proceedings for
13 Reactor Operator and Senior Reactor Operator Licensing
14 Adjudications.

15 Here the Commission is being asked to
16 approve a final rule which provides procedures for the
17 use of informal adjudicatory procedures in non-
18 enforcement operator licensing proceedings. The Rule
19 also includes express permission for an applicant to
20 include within the request for a hearing a request
21 that the presiding officers will recommend to the
22 Commission that procedures other than those specified
23 in Subpart L be used in the proceeding.

24 All Commissioners have approved the final
25 rule as attached to our memorandum of August the 15th.


