SECRETARY CHILK: The first item, Mr. Chairman, is SECY-90-209. It is the final 1990 Waste Confidence Decision and Amendments to 10 CFR Part 51.

In this paper, the Commission is being asked to approve issuance of a final waste confidence decision review and final conforming amendments to 10 CFR Part 51. As a result of its review, the Commission has revised the second and fourth findings of the 1984 Waste Confidence Decision and has reaffirmed the other three findings.

The Commission is also changing its original commitment to review its decision at least every five years to a commitment to review the decision at least every ten years or when significant

and pertinent unexpected events occur.

All Commissioners have approved the final decision review and the conforming amendments to 10 CFR Part 51 with modifications that are attached to ou memorandum of August the 15th.

SECRETARY CHILK: The second item is SECY-90-255. It's a Final Rule on Informal Proceedings for Reactor Operator and Senior Reactor Operator Licensing Adjudications.

Here the Commission is being asked to approve a final rule which provides procedures for the use of informal adjudicatory procedures in non-enforcement operator licensing proceedings. The Rule also includes express permission for an applicant to include within the request for a hearing a request that the presiding officers will recommend to the Commission that procedures other than those specified in Subpart L be used in the proceeding.

All Commissioners have approved the final rule as attached to our memorandum of August the 15th.
