# Management Meeting Summary

Licensee: Nebraska Public Power District

Docket: 50-298

On July 20, 1990, licensee management met with representatives of the NRC staff to discuss Emergency Action Level (EAL) changes made to the Emergency Plan in August 1989. These changes were implemented without NRC approval because in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(q), the licensee determined that the changes did not decrease the effectiveness of the Plan. After review of the changes by the NRC staff, questions were raised with respect to the EAL changes and a request for additional information was sent to the licensee on March 16, 1990.

The licensee responded to the request for additional information by letter dated May 1, 1990. Reg on IV received NRC headquarters evaluation of the impact of the changes, and the licensee information justifying these changes, by memorandum dated June 19, 1990. The NRC staff position was that five of the changed EALs represented a lowering of the threshold for classifying certain emergencies and therefore decreased the effectiveness of the Plan in this area.

During the meeting 'ne licensee expressed the reasons behind the changes as an effort to clarify for decisionmakers the initiating events, and to bring some of the events into conformance with technical specifications. The licensee stated that it was never their intent to lower classification thresholds and that their reading of the changes was different than the NRC staff's.

The NRC staff reviewed the five EALs in question and highlighted the specific wording that represented a significant departure from the previous EALs and from NRC guidance as contained in NUREG 0654. The licensee committed to revise the five EALs to conform with the NRC position by October 12, 1990, and to provide the revisions to NRC for review. The specific EALs to be revised are 3.2.3; 5.2.1; 3.3.3; 5.3.1; and 5.3.2. In addition to the revision, the licensee committed to provide written interim guidance to emergency decisionmakers regarding the EALs and the NRC positions discussed during the meeting.
