The purpose of this modification is to revise the contract to include the Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board's (the Board) requirements for testing and analysis of employee/applicant urine specimens under its drug testing program. The minimum and maximum quantities shown in Section B.3, "Pricing Schedule", do not change as a result of this modification. Accordingly, the contract is modified as follows:

1. Section B.1, paragraph "a.", second sentence is revised to read:

"The urine specimens will be collected and submitted from NRC Headquarters, Regional Offices, and Remote Sites, and from the Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board (the Board)."

2. Section B.1, paragraph "b.", second sentence is revised to add the following words after "NRC":

"or the Board. . ."

Section B.1, paragraph "b", add the following sentence:

"Orders issued by the Board will include specific billing instructions and will obligate the necessary funds."

3. Add the following new paragraph to Section C.1.1, "Background":

"This contract shall also cover the urine specimen testing and analysis requirements of the Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board (the Board)."

4. In Sections C.1., D.1, D.2, E.2, E.3, F.4, F.5, G.3, H.6 and H.7 of the contract, references to the "NRC" are interchangeable with "the Board", references to the "NRC Project Officer" are interchangeable with "the Board Project Officer", references to the "NRC Medical Review Officer" are interchangeable with "the Board Medical Review Officer" and references to the "NRC's Drug Testing Program" are interchangeable with "the Board's Drug Testing Program".

5. In Section G.1, "Project Officer Authority", paragraph a, add the following:

6. Attachment Numbers 1, 2, 4, 5, and 6 apply only to the NRC. Billing instructions for the Board will appear on individual orders issued under this contract. A copy of the Board's Drug Testing Plan will be incorporated after its approval by HHS.

All other terms and conditions, including the ceiling amount of \$23,315.00, remain the same.
