Dear Mr. Bruce:

This refers to our telephone conversation of July 30, 1990, regarding the status of your NRC Byproduct Materials License No. 24-24541-01. Based upon our discussion, it is my understanding that your two radiography sources (Iridium-192) have not been used since approximately October 1989, and are being stored in their authorized storage location at 4560 Shaw. It is also my understanding that you are not planning to renew your NRC license upon its expiration on September 30, 1990 and in fact are making arrangements for the disposition of your sources and exposure devices. It is my understanding that these sources will be transferred to an authorized recipient within the next 60 days at which time you will formally request license termination. Enclosed with this memorandum is a NRC Form 314 for your use in requesting license termination. This form should be completed and signed by you and then forwarded to this office to the attention of Rose Pankratz.
