The inspection was conducted in response to information received by NRC Region III regarding possession and use of byproduct material under your general license. It is our understanding that you have been receiving radioimmunoassay (RIA) kits from Mr. Thomas Kralian as part of a research project for quite some time. Your receipt, possession, and use of these kits is not authorized by your General License. This constitutes a violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice. A written response is required.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. These areas include a summary of events and interviews.
