Dear Mr. Beach:

On August 14, 1990, I returned to Petro Data (formerly B & H Wireline Services) in Wynona, Oklahoma. On that date I conducted a second audit of their operations involving radioactive materials. The following is my report:

1. Their records pertaining to their safe use of radioactive materials have been totally revised and updated. All the miscellaneous forms, reports, regulations, etc. have been selectively placed into easily accessible files. New files have been established for the relatively new regulatory requirements (10CFR Part 39) i.e. Annual Logging Supervisor Inspection, Annual Safety Review, Semi-Annual Equipment Maintenance Inspection, etc.

New survey forms have been established that comply with the requirements of 10CFR Part 39. These forms are to be put in use by 9/15/90.

The new files and new forms should make it easier for Mr. Haught to keep track of the necessary paper work that is generated by the safe keeping of the radioactive sources.

2. Downhole storage is being installed outside of their facility in Wynona which will give them proper storage capability at both Hominey and Wynona.
3. Source shields on the truck (one truck was in) were secured (both to the truck and properly locked) and correctly labeled.

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
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I will again visit their operations on or about September 15th and will report to you shortly thereafter.
