This preliminary notification constitutes EARLY notice of events of POSSIBLE safety or public interest significance. The information is as initially received without verification or evaluation, and is basically all that is known by the Region II staff on this date.

SUBJECT: AIT DISPATCHED TO BRUNSWICK STEAM ELECTRIC PLANT

The NRC has dispatched an augmented inspection team (AIT) to the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant to investigate the circumstances surrounding the Unit 2 reactor trip which occurred on August 19, 1990, at 9:54 p.m. (EDT). The Unit tripped from 100 percent power when the main steam isolation valves went closed, from what appears to be an inadequately performed/controlled surveillance test. At this time, it is known that several safety relief valves failed to open on increasing reactor pressure and reactor core isolation coolin, system tripped on what appears to be related to valve thermal overload. The Unit has been taken to Cold Shutdown in order to effect repairs.

The State of North Carolina has been informed.
