Semiannual Radioactive Effluent Release Report
San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, Units 1, 2 and 3

Technical Specification (TS) Section 6.9.1.8 to Provisional Operating License DPR-13, Facility Operating Licenses NPF-10 and NPF-15 for San Onofre Units 1, 2, and 3, respectively, requires SCE provide a Semiannual Radioactive Effluent Release Report (SRERP) covering the operation of the units during the previous six months of operation. The SRERP for the period January 1 through June 30, 1990, is provided in Enclosure I.

Unit 1 TS Section 6.9.1.9 requires SCE report in the SRERP any changes made to the Process Control Program (PCP), changes to the Offsite Dose Calculation Manual (ODCM); or, any major changes to the radioactive waste treatment systems during the reporting period. On February 1, 1990, changes made to the Unit 1 ODCM were implemented as Revision 5A. The ODCM pages affected by the changes are included in the SRERP. There were no changes made to the PCP or any major changes made to the radioactive waste treatment systems for Unit 1.

Units 2 and 3 TS Section 6.14.2.3 requires SCE submit to the Commission, whenever a change is made to the ODCM, a complete copy of the ODCM, as part of, or concurrent with the SRERP for the period of the report in which the ODCM changes were made. On February 1 and February 15, 1990, changes made to the Units 2 and 3 ODCM were implemented as Revision 20A and Revision 21, respectively. Since Revision 21 includes the Revision 20A changes, SCE is providing a complete copy of the ODCM, Revision 21, as Enclosure II.
