

UNITED STATES NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSIONINDIANA MICHIGAN POWER COMPANYDOCKET NOS. 50-315 AND 50-316NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION FORAMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

The United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has granted the request of Indiana Michigan Power Company (the licensee) to withdraw its March 4, 1989 application for proposed amendment to Facility Operating License Nos. DPR-58 and DPR-74 for the Donald C. Cook Nuclear Plant, Units Nos. 1 and 2, located in Berrien County, Michigan.

The proposed amendment would have revised Technical Specification (TS) G.12.2 to permit the posting of designated individuals to serve as substitutes for locked doors to prevent access to high radiation areas in those instances in which providing a locked door is not possible or practical due to area size or configuration.

The Commission has previously issued a Notice of Consideration of Issuance of Amendment published in the FEDERAL REGISTER on November 15, 1989 (54 FR 47605). However, by letter dated June 25, 1990, the licensee withdrew the proposed change.
