Dear Mr. Davis:

In Reference (a), Commonwealth Edison defined two specific commitments in response to the Notice of Violation. This letter revises the schedule for one of the commitments.

- The first commitment was to inspect all vital barriers to determine areas vulnerable to degradation as a result of equipment removal (such as pipes, vents and floors) due to operations and maintenance. This commitment was completed on June 18, 1990.
- 2. The second commitment was to lahel all vital barriers to ensure security is notified prior to the barrier being degraded. This effort was started on July 18, 1990, and is not approximately 25% complete. The work is now on hold pending receipt of signs from a vendor that will be used on barriers where painted labels are unable to be used. The signs are expected to be available by October 1, 1990. The remainder of the labeling will then be completed by November 1, 1990.
