Reply to a Notice of Violation:

Attachment 10.4, Item 14 of the license application requires that the laboratory be locked when personnel are not present.

The door to the nuclear medicine hot lab was unlocked and open, and personnel were not present in the scanning area. The hot lab is located beside the scanning area within the radiology department, where staff were working. The scanning area and hot lab are also located along a private hallway which is clearly marked private. Our interpretation of Item 14 was that the door to the hot lab would be locked when nuclear medicine personnel were not present in the hospital. The employee on duty at the time of the violation was in the building.

As a corrective action we have made a key available to nuclear medicine staff in a specified location and the door is now closed and locked whenever staff are not within the scanning area. This action was taken on June 13, 1990, and we have been in full compliance since that date.
