1. a) Corrective steps that have been taken:

The required training for supervisory nursing personnel
has been scheduled for September 6, 1990.

- b) Results Achieved:


Nursing Service is now better informed that this is a
requirement under the hospital's NRC license.

2. Corrective steps taken to avoid further violations:

Review indicated that the required 1989 training was
scheduled and then cancelled several times due to a nursing
personnel shortage. All annual training and similar
requirements will be listed on a check list in the radiation
safety office. The completion of each training session or
other required action will be initialed and dated on the
check list. A review of this check list and pending items
will be a part of the monthly radiation safety staff
meetings.

3. Date when full compliance will be achieved: September
6, 1990.
