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

Gentlemen:

Attached is a submittal of NRC Form 314 - "Certificate of Disposition of Materials" for UNC Recovery Systems, 149 Narragansett Trail, Charlestown, RI. Based on the site decontamination results previously reported to you, the confirmatory surveys performed for you by ORAU, and the removal of all licensed nuclear materials from the site, you are requested to terminate our NRC License 70-820/SNM-777.

UNC has devoted significant efforts and resources over the past several years towards assuring that the site meets all applicable NRC release requirements, as well as attaining conformance with the ALARA (as low as reasonably achievable) principle. We have worked closely and cooperatively with NRC staff to achieve these goals, and have consistently adopted a conservative approach towards assuring regulatory compliance. As a result, we feel that the site can now be released for unrestricted use without reservation, and are requesting the NRC to grant that release as soon as possible.
