REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING PRESSURE-TEMPERATURE LIMITS GRAND GULF NUCLEAR STATION (GGNS), UNIT 1

By letter dated April 26, 1990, the licensee (System Energy Resources, Inc. prior to June 6, 1990 and Entergy Operations, Inc. after that date) requested a change to the reactor vessel pressure-temperature limits in GGNS Unit 1 Technical Specifications. The NRC staff is reviewing the submittal and had a teleconference with the licensee on September 7, 1990. The NRC staff finds that the following additional information is needed to complete its review.

- (1) Provide the analysis of flux wire dosimeters removed from the GGNS Unit 1 reactor vessel during the first refueling outage.
- (2) Provide a discussion of the basis for the fluence uncertainty of ±20% from the flux wire analysis.
- (3) Provide the basis for the peak fluence revision from 1.9x10 neutrons/square centimeter (n/cm²) to 2.4x10 n/cm².
- (4) Provide the azimuthal fluence estimate at the reactor vessel inside diameter projected for the end of life (or any other available time).
