
In accordance with License Condition No. 19 of U.S. NRC License SUA-551, we are reporting the results of the land survey conducted August 20 through 23, 1990.

There has been no change in the land use in the area within five miles of any portion of the restricted area boundary surrounding the Petrotomics Mill site in the last year. Petrotomics stopped mining in the area adjacent to and north of the restricted area in 1985. Reclamation is in progress for the Pit-4 area, but it is still considered mine lands for land use purposes. Reclamation of the tailings and Mill site is in progress.

The mine lands to the east and south of Petrotomics are being reclaimed by The Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, Abandon Mine Lands Division. Reclamation began in the fall of 1987. Work is continuing in this area.
