This modification accomplishes the following:

1. Revises the contract scope of work for within scope efforts;
2. Raises the contract ceiling by \$30,535.00;
3. Adds funds in the amount of \$205,000.00; and
4. Changes the designated NRC Project Officer.

As a result, the following changes are hereby made:

1. Section C - Description/Specification/Work Statement, Task 2.3 Operations, is hereby modified to include efforts as described in Attachment I of this Modification No. 14.
2. Section B.2 CONSIDERATION AND OBLIGATION--COST PLUS FIXED FEE, paragraphs a., c., and e., are revised to read as follows:
 - "a. It is estimated that the total cost to the Government for full performance of the base year, and the first and second options years will be \$13,424,606.59, of which the sum of \$12,577,122.50 represents the estimated reimbursable costs, and of which \$847,484.09 represents the fixed fee."
 - "c. The amount presently obligated by the Government with respect to this contract is \$13,497,780.59. However, the contractor's incurred costs shall not exceed \$13,424,606.59 without the prior written approval from the NRC Contracting Officer. The remaining funds of \$73,174.00, obligated under this modification, are hereby set aside until such written approval has been provided the contractor. This restriction does not, in any way, change or eliminate the requirements set forth in the Limitation of Cost - 52.232-20 or Limitation of Funds - 52.232-22 Clauses of the Contract."
 - "e. The total estimated cost for the second option year is \$4,114,309.00, of which \$3,847,728.00 represents the estimated reimbursable costs, and of which \$266,581.00 represents the fixed fee."
3. Section G.2 PROJECT OFFICER AUTHORITY, paragraph a. is hereby revised to read as follows:


STATEMENT OF WORK

The contractor is required to process approximately 1,400 documents in addition to the normal workflow. Processing includes document coding, data entry, microfilming and quality assurance activities normally applied in the NUDOCS operations. The contractor is required to adhere to "Backfit" procedures developed in previous efforts of this type. The NRC Division of Information Support Services/ Information Resources Management Branch (DISS/IRMB) will provide the Monticello documents to be processed. After processing, the files will be returned to IRMB.




