This modification is issued to exercise the second option year period, extending the duration of the contract period an additional 12 months through August 28, 1991 in accordance with Sections F.2 Duration of Contract Period and I.3 Option to Extend the Term of the Contract--Services (52.217-9). Work during the option period shall be performed as specified under the basic contract and in accordance with Section B.3. This modification also confirms the the August 6, 1990 telecon between Edna Knox-Davin, NRC Contract Administrator and Thomas Hutchens of DCCA in which the Contractor waived its right to preliminary written notice of exercise of this option.

As a result of this action, incremental funds of \$57,000.00 are provided which increase the obligated amount of this contract from \$210,000.00 to \$267,000.00 and the contract ceiling amount is increased to \$395,538.80. Accordingly, the contract is hereby modified as follows:

1. Under Section B.2 Consideration and Obligation/Contract Ceiling, the first sentence of paragraphs a. and b. are revised to read as follows:
  - "a. The total amount to the Government for the work specified in Section C herein shall not exceed \$395,538.80.
  - b. The amount presently obligated with respect to this contract is \$267,000.00."
2. Under Section F.2 Duration of Contract Period, the first sentence is revised to read as follows:

"This contract shall commence on August 29, 1988 and will expire on August 28, 1991."

NOTE: Verbal authorization to continue services provided for under this contract was granted by the NRC Contracting Officer on August 28, 1990.

All other terms and conditions of the contract remain unchanged.
