APPARENT VIOLATIONS

1. Failure to describe radioactive material on shipping papers during transportation. (49 CFR Part 172.200(a))
2. Failure to maintain documentation of tests and an engineering evaluation showing that the cases used to transport radioactive material comply with Department of Transportation Specification 7A, Type A criteria. (49 CFR 173.415(a))
3. Failure to enter the activity on Radioactive White I labels used on two packages containing radioactive material during transportation and failure to enter the activity and the transport index on Radioactive Yellow II labels, placed on a third package. (49 CFR 172.403(g))
4. Failure to mark two packages containing radioactive material with the proper shipping name and the identification number. (49 CFR 172.301)
5. Failure to assure by examinations or tests, that the external contamination levels on packages transported were within the allowable limits, 49 CFR 173.475 (i).
