In reference to your letter dated September 7, 1990, Docket number 30-30691, I submit the following:

ARTICLE I

- A. I admit to the charges in this paragraph. The radiographer was rushed by the contractor to the point errors were made on his part. Mr. Croteau has been made aware of the severe nature of his actions and the consequences of them. I will check more frequently on a non-reported basis to see that my instructions have been carried out. To date, Mr. Croteau has complied completely. Compliance has been achieved.
- B. I deny whole body over exposure on two (2) individuals. We admit over exposure on one. Mr. Croteau's film badge was processed and the results were less than 3R. Oklahoma Medical Center gave a non-conclusive report; although, Oak Ridge, Tennessee gave a higher reading. They also gave a wide range and a low percentage rate for accuracy. I do not feel that I can possibly place any credibility on this report. The reasons for and the corrective action taken are the same as Paragraph A. Also, 5R alarm monitors will be implemented as soon as they are available. Implementation date to be December 31, 1990.

ARTICLE II

A. I admit to these charges. The assistant was rushed by the contractor to the point of error. The assistant has been terminated. All new hires will be told that film badges and dosemeters will be worn as required; any violation of this rule will result in termination. Full compliance is immediate.

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B. I admit to the charges in this paragraph. The vendor reported the film badges had been either heat or water damaged. Failure to log exposure was an oversight on my part. I will more closely monitor the dosemetry reports from the vendor to avoid further violation of this nature. Full compliance has been achieved.
