This refers to your letter dated May 10, 1990, in response to our letter dated April 21, 1990, and to the telephone conversation on August 17, 1990, between Ralph Sgambato of your staff and Steven Courtemanche of this office.

After further review of Appendix K of Regulatory Guide 10.8, Revision 1 by our staff, it has been decided to withdraw the apparent item of noncompliance found in our letter dated April 21, 1990. Your present practice is within the legal basis of your license.

During the telephone conversation of August 17, 1990, Mr. Sgambato stated that the wearing of film badges by nurses attending patients that have received therapeutic doses of radiopharmaceuticals had been reinstituted. This was done at the suggestion of the inspector soon after the inspection of March 8, 1990, as a good radiological practice. Please note, however, that Appendix R of Regulatory Guide 10.8, Revision 2 requires the wearing of film badges, TLD's or dosimeters. The Model Program in Appendix R will supercede your present procedures when your license is renewed.
