- 1. We have reviewed the violations listed in the above report and have instituted corrective actions for all of them.
  - a. All radioactive waste is now held the minimum 10 half lives and measures have been taken to enforce this requirement.
  - b. 1) The technologist was instructed in the proper performance of the dose calibration constancy test using precalculated values.
    - 2) The records of survey results now include all required information including survey units, survey meters' model and serial numbers. A new form is being developed to assist with standardization of data recording.
    - 3) Ministerial changes in the receipt procedures for radioactive materials and the dose calibration accuracy test procedures have now been recorded in the procedings of the Radioisotope Committee.
- 2. Instructions were given by the RSO to all technologists the day of the visit. Followup instruction will be given periodically and will also address new regulations forthcoming.
- 3. We appreciate the thoroughness and courtesy of the inspector and will continue to extend all efforts to maintain full compliance with NRC requirements.
