The results of this inspection also showed that certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements. Therefore, the violation will not be subject to enforcement action because your efforts in identifying and correcting the violation meet the criteria specified in Section VII.B of the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," (Enforcement Policy, 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C).
