Subject: Systematic Assessment of Licensee Performance (SALP) and SCE Letter dated December 3, 1982

This refers to the SALP for San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, Units 2 and 3, conducted by this office on August 18, 1982, and discussed with your staff at a meeting on November 8, 1982. The list of attendees is attached as Enclosure 1. The NRC Region V SALP report is attached as Enclosure 2 and covers the period of July 1, 1981 through June 30, 1982. Southern California Edison Company letter, dated December 3, 1982, which we requested in our letter dated October 18, 1982, provided your comments and commitments for performance improvement and is attached as Enclosure 3.

Overall, your performance of licensed activities was found to be acceptable and directed toward quality facility construction and safe facility operation.

In the construction areas of Containment and Safety-Related Structures, Electrical Power Supply and Distribution, Quality Assurance, Design, and Licensee Response to NRC Initiatives, we found your management attention and involvement to be aggressive and the effective use of resources have resulted in a high level of performance. In the operations areas of Emergency Preparedness, Initial Fuel Loading, and your efforts toward TMI Action Item completion, we found that a high degree of management attention and involvement and effective use of your resources resulted in a high level of performance.

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Southern California Edison Company

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During the meeting of November 8, 1982, we discussed our assessment of your regulatory performance in these areas, your comments on the SALP program and assessment, and the actions you are taking to improve your facility operations. We have also reviewed your letter of December 3, 1982, and determined that your actions to improve performance are responsive.

We consider that our meeting was beneficial and improved mutual understanding of your activities and our regulatory program. Based on your comments during the meeting and your December 3, 1982 letter, we have found that no changes to our assessment are appropriate. We have been advised by the Office of NRR that they do not concur with your comment that the frequency of emergency Technical Specification changes is justified and appropriate. Therefore, our overall assessment of the Licensing Activities area remains unchanged from our draft SALP report.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and its enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room. No reply to this letter is required. Your actions in response to the NRC Systematic Assessment of Licensee Performance will be reviewed during future inspections of your licensed activities.
