Subject: STOLEN MOISTURE-DENSITY GAGE

On February 24, 1994, the Walnut Creek, California, police department informed the Headquarters Operations Officer that a moisture-density gage, manufactured by Campbell-Pacific Nuclear Corporation, had been reported stolen from the back of a pickup truck. The truck belonged to an employee of the Buller Group and was parked at the employee's home. The gage was locked in its safe position and secured in a travel case. The activity of the source in the gage is not known.

The Walnut Creek Police intends to issue a press release. There is substantial local media interest.

Region V received initial notification of this occurrence by telephone from the Headquarters Operations Officer at 10:37 p.m. on February 24, 1994.

The information presented herein has been discussed with the California Radiological Health Branch, and is current as of 8:30 a.m. PST, February 25, 1994. The State is following-up on the matter
