Subject: STATE PANEL REJECTS PROPOSED LOW-LEVEL WASTE DISPOSAL SITE

On October 9, 1992, a state radioactive waste review commission rejected the proposed site for a low-level radioactive waste disposal facility at Martinsville, Illinois. The site would have served the Central Midwest Compact, which includes Illinois and Kentucky.

The three-member commission was named in 1989 to review the site which had been selected by the Illinois Department of Nuclear Safety. The commission, which rejected the site by a 3-0 vote, expressed concerns about the size of the site, possible affect on municipal water supplies, quality control measures during site characterization work, the inventory the facility would hold, and its ability to last 500 or more years.

Illinois Governor Jim Edgar announced the state would abide by the decision, and he directed the state agency to stop all efforts to locate the facility at Martinsville.

There has been statewide news media interest in the state commission's decision.
