Subject: STOLEN MOISTURE-DENSITY GAUGE
On January 18, 1993, the Parke County Sheriff's Department reported that a moisture-density gauge had been stolen from a highway field office at a temporary job site on Indiana Highway 234 at Lodi, Indiana. The gauge was taken in a break-in which occurred between $4 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$ on January 15 , and $9 \mathrm{a} . \mathrm{m}$. on January 18 . Other office and engineering equipment was also taken in the break-in.

The gauge's source rod was locked in its shielded position, and the gauge was stored in its transport container. The gauge contained an 8 millicurie cesium-137 sealed source and a 40 millicurie americium-241 sealed source.

The licensee notified appropriate state and local agencies and issued a news announcement on the missing gauge. There has been news media coverage of the theft.

The State of Indiana has been notified. The information in this preliminary notification has been reviewed with licensee management. Region III (Chicago) will review the circumstances surrounding the theft during a future inspection.

The sheriff's department notified the NRC operations center of the theft at about 9:46 am. (EST) on January 18, 1993. This information is current as of $1: 00 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$. on January 19, 1993.
