Fitness for Duty Performance Data Report

During this reporting period (July through December 1993), Portland General Electric Company (PGE) implemented the Trojan Nuclear Plant Security plan (Defueled Condition). This Security Plan contains a commitment that a Fitness for Duty Program will be maintained which implements the requirements of 10 CFR Part 26.

Effectiveness Summary

No positive drug tests occurred during this reporting period.

During the reporting period, the Fitness for Duty Program was subjected to an internal Quality Assurance audit. Although minor program enhancements were initiated as a result of the audit, no programmatic concerns were identified. The audit summary stated that "Overall, the Security and Fitness for Duty activities evaluated during the audit demonstrated that the requirements are complied with and effectively implemented."

Events Reported

No reportable events occurred during the six-month reporting period.

Statistical Summary

During the reporting period, the Fitness for Duty Program conducted 80 preaccess drug and alcohol tests, 245 random drug and alcohol tests, 1 reasonable suspicion test, 0 post accident tests, and 4 follow-up drug and alcohol tests. PGE's overall positive rate for the random screening program was 0.0 percent (0.0 percent for PGE employees and 0.0 percent for contractor personnel). The overall positive rate for the preaccess screening program is 0.0 percent for the reporting period (0.0 percent for PGE applicants and 0.0 percent for contract personnel). The positive rate for all screening during the period July 1, 1993 through December 31, 1993 was 0.0 percent.

PGE's average plant population during the reporting period was 354. The total number of random tests was 245. At the end of the reporting period, PGE had randomly screened 69 percent of the average plant population granted protected area unescorted access. Total random screening for 1993 was 126 percent.
