5. Preoperational Test Program Implementation (37301)

The inspectors verified that the as built condition of the safety injection and containment cooling systems were consistent with the approved drawings identified in the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR) revision 12. Verification was completed for the containment cooling system and is eighty percent complete for the safety injection system.
