AFFIDAVIT OF BERNAL N. FEMREITE

I, Bernal N. Femreite, being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. I am Richland Plant Manager of Siemens Power Corporation - Nuclear Division, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware, with offices at 2101 Horn Rapids Road, City of Richland, County of Benton, State of Washington, and on whose behalf I make this affidavit.
2. I am familiar with the contents of the two documents requested by U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and Science Applications International Corporation personnel during the license renewal review meetings December 14-16 at Richland, Washington.
3. The two Siemens Power Corporation-Nuclear Division documents mentioned in paragraph 2, above:
 - Procedure No. P66,820, Revision 5, "Process Startup and Shutdown - Line 1"; and
 - Document No. EMF-1577(P), "Waste Management Engineering Plan"

(i) have been held in confidence by Siemens Power Corporation pursuant to its internal policies, (ii) is the types of information that is normally held in confidence by Siemens Power Corporation in order to protect it as valuable trade secret which gives a competitive advantage to Siemens Power Corporation and which information, if given to a competitor, would be valuable to such competitors, without them having to expend any funds and in allowing them to know what processes Siemens Power Corporation is contemplating, (iii) are presented to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission in confidence, (iv) are not available from public sources and (v) public disclosure of the information would cause harm to Siemens Power Corporation by allowing competitors free access to information which Siemens Power Corporation developed at its own time and expense, which information would not be easily acquired by another company and would give competitors free access to information on Siemens Power Corporation's manufacturing processes.

I am authorized to make the statements that are set forth herein on behalf of Siemens Power Corporation and the statements made in this affidavit are, to the best of knowledge, information and belief, truthful and complete.
