Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. D. R. Gibbons of this office on December 15, 1982, of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License No. 22-01870-06 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. E. E. Grande and selected members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

In addition to the above areas, the inspector examined actions described in your letters dated January 30, 1980, April 10, 1980 and October 21, 1980, regarding apparent items of noncompliance found during our December 13 and 14, 1979 inspection.
