I agree with the staff's recommendations in the paper with the exceptions noted below:

1. With respect to unlocking of vital area doors, I agree with Commissioner Remick's comments.
2. For response to vital area alarms, I agree that relief should be provided from responding to "nuisance" alarms, if such alarms can be identified (such as certain types of alarms); however, potentially valid alarms should be responded to. Thus, I do not agree with the proposals to respond only to a certain percentage of alarms, or to respond to a VA alarm only if there is an unresolved PA alarm (or intrusion).
