Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Ms. E. Matson of this office on November 17, 1982, of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License No. 21-13562-01 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. J. Collins, Dr. M. Chopp, Dr. A. Reidinger, and Mr. A. Raffarelle at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in non-compliance with NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Appendix A. A written response is required.

In addition to the specific items of noncompliance, and as expressed in a telephone management conference on December 3, 1982, between Mr. D. J. Sreniawski, Ms. E. R. Matson, you, and members of your staff, we are concerned about the large number of items of noncompliance identified during this inspection. It appears that your management's review system and a lack of awareness of your specific NRC license requirements may have permitted these items to occur.

Consequently, in your reply to this letter, please describe those actions taken or planned to improve the effectiveness of your management control over your licensed activities so as to preclude the recurrence of these or similar items of noncompliance. Enclosed is Appendix B, "Management Control" to provide you with some guidance for your response.


