Safety Evaluation Report for Environmental Qualification
of Safety-Related Electric Equipment

The subject Safety Evaluation Report (SER) was received by Portland General Electric Company on December 23, 1982. As directed by the SER, we have commenced our review of the Technical Evaluation Report attached to the SER to determine which portions are considered proprietary. In that regard, copies must be forwarded to Westinghouse, the Trojan NSSF vendor, for review and confirmation. As a result, we do not feel such a determination can be made within the seven days allotted. We respectfully request an additional two weeks to complete this determination. As such, we would propose to submit no later than January 14, 1983, our conclusions as to which sections of the SER are considered proprietary and a schedule for submittal of the specific rationale and justification for such conclusions. Until such responses are received, we ask that the entire SER be considered proprietary.
