Pursuant to the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's Order (Prehearing Conference Order), dated February 1, 1994, the staff of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (Staff) hereby submits its second status report on criminal referrals regarding certain matters related to the above-captioned proceeding made to the Department of Justice (DOJ) by the NRC Office of Investigations (OI).


As noted in the Staff's first status report on criminal referrals to DOJ, dated February 7, 1994, one matter relative to this proceeding has been determined by the Assistant United States Attorney for the Western District of Pennsylvania to warrant a criminal investigation into possible violations of federal law. 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Since the filing of the Staff's first status report there have been no new developments in the investigation.

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
