### NRC STAFF'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.730, the NRC Staff ("Staff") hereby requests an extension of time for the filing of responses to the "Motion for Summary Disposition" filed by Intervenors Ohio Citizens for Responsible Energy ("OCRE") and Susan L. Hiatt on February 7, 1994. In support of this request, the Staff states as follows.

On February 16, 1994, the Licensing Board issued an Order establishing a schedule for the filing of responses to Inter enors' Motion, in accordance with an earlier conference call. That schedule contemplated that the Staff would file a response to Intervenors' Motion by March 2, 1994; the Licensee would file its response and a cross-motion for summary disposition by March 9, 1994; and the Intervenors would reply to the Licensee (and Staff) within 21 days after the Licensee's motion is filed.

Due to the unavailability of certain members of the Staff this week, the Staff requires a brief extension of time for the 'lling of its response to the Intervenors' Motion. The Staff has

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discussed this matter with Counsel for the Licensee and Ms. Hiatt, and is authorized to state that the parties have agreed to the Staff's request for an extension, so long as their response times are also adjusted, as follows: Staff response to Intervenors' Motion due March 7, 1994; Licensee's response to Intervenors' Motion and Licensee's cross motion due March 21, 1994; Intervenors' reply to Licensee (and Staff) due April 11, 1994.

Wherefore, the Staff respectfully requests an extension of time for the filing of responses to Intervenors' Motion, as set forth above.
