SUBJECT: DENIAL OF AMENDMENT REQUEST (TAC NO. M88252 AND M88253)(TS 93-17)

By letter dated November 18, 1993, TVA submitted technical specification change request no. 93-17 for the Sequoyah Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2. The amendment request proposed that License Condition 2.H be deleted from the Operating License. This license condition requires that violations of certain specified license conditions be reported to the NRC Regional Office. After careful review, the NRC staff has concluded that the request cannot be approved. The basis for this finding is documented in the enclosed evaluation.

A copy of the Notice of Denial and Opportunity for Hearing has been forwarded to the Office of Federal Register for publication.
