


AMENDMENT OF THE DESCRIPTION OF THE FACILITY ENDORSEMENT

It is agreed that Item 3 of the Declarations, "Description of the Facility" as amended by Endorsement No. 27 is further amended to read:


Location All of the premises including the land and all buildings and structures of Portland General Electric Company's Trojan Nuclear Plant situated on a site consisting of approximately 623 acres including those premises located east and west of the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railroad right of way and west of Highway 30, but excluding the Trojan Visitor Information Center.

The Trojan Nuclear Plant is located on the Columbia River at River Mile 72.5 from the mouth in Columbia County, Oregon approximately twelve (12) miles northwest of the town of St. Helens and four (4) miles southeast of the town of Rainier, Oregon.




